CALL FOR PROPOSALS

In this forum, we will discuss how institutions engaged in integrative learning have evolved in their thinking. We are specifically interested in organizing panel sessions around these four topics related to integrated learning:

- Equity and Inclusion
- Integrative Learning
- Faculty Development
- Civic Engagement

Themes to be addressed under these topics may include: integrative learning in the humanities, sciences, and/or professional programs; diversity, inclusion, and integrative learning; the impact of community partners within the classroom; the impact of the integrative model on faculty teaching and scholarship; recent research and scholarship on learning and the integrative model; team-teaching and its impact on faculty and students; integrative learning and retention; the role of integrative learning in first year experiences; integrative learning for the evolving twenty-first century student.

Concurrent sessions will be one hour in length. There will be two to three panel presenters per session. Presentations should be no longer than 15 minutes so that there is time for discussion about shared models, best practices and challenges.
